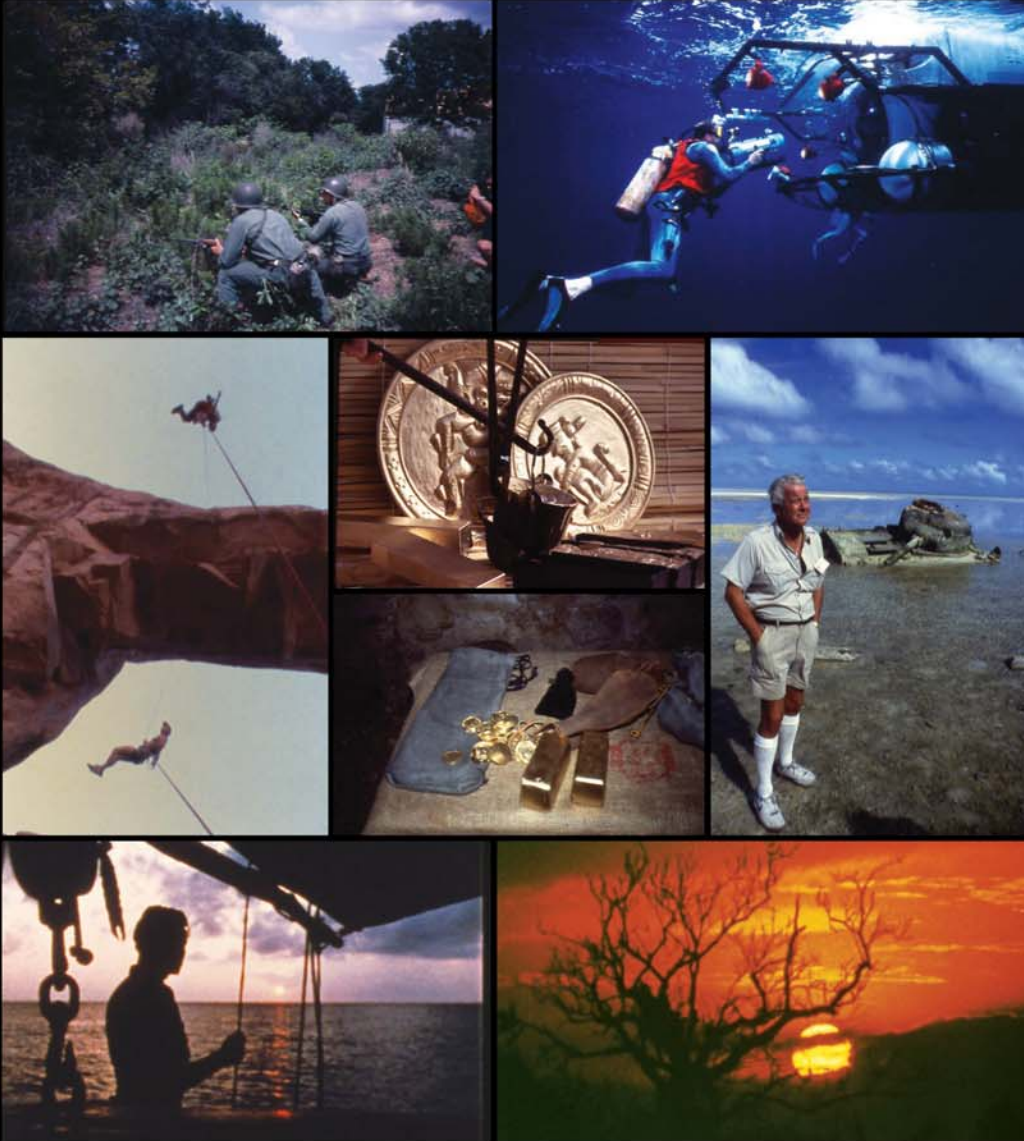

CURSE OF THE MAYAN TEMPLE (1 x 90) — 1981

A lost city in the jungle beckons two young adventurers to an ancient Mayan civilization where they uncover great mysteries and sacred tribal rituals that lead to a struggle between life and death.

DEVIL'S MOUNTAIN (1 x 90) — 1980

A savage shark attack on diver Tom Hinshaw convinces him to return to Bora Bora, the source of his taboo, where he must remove the curse placed upon him.

EXPLORERS OF THE WILD (1 x 60) — 2000

Follow in the footsteps of the great explorers such as Lewis and Clark, and view the unique wild and natural world through their eyes as they treaded through unknown lands.

THE GREAT AMERICAN WILDERNESS (1 x 90) — 1977

The wondrous discoveries of virgin American lands by early explorers have long since eroded into concrete and asphalt. THE GREAT AMERICAN WILDERNESS vividly re-enacts and dramatizes how it was for land and for animals.

MAN AGAINST THE SEAS (1 x 90) — 1980

Trace man's exploration of the sea from 1926 to the present, vividly portraying his ongoing attempts to unlock the mysteries of the sea and its untapped wealth.

MONTEZUMA'S LOST GOLD (1 x 90) — 1981

A true story set in the 1800's of one man who sought to find Montezuma's great treasure and whose greed for gold became so great that his obsession led to death.

REMEMBERING TARAWA (1 x 60) — 1991

REMEMBERING TARAWA takes us behind the scenes of the filming of RETURN TO TARAWA. Shot on location on the island of Betio in the Central Pacific, REMEMBERING TARAWA will feature continuing interviews with the men who survived this campaign in the Pacific and historical footage taken during the battle.

RETURN TO TARAWA (1 x 60) — 1990

RETURN TO TARAWA takes a retrospective look at this battle, in part, through graphic combat footage, filmed at great personal risk by courageous navy and marine cameramen. Their footage reveals the intensity of a savage battle where no telephoto lens was needed to spot the enemy. RETURN TO TARAWA peaks with some very touching and emotional interviews with returning veterans.

TREASURE! (13 x 60) — 1990

Hosted by Phillip Michael Thomas, this series follows famous and infamous treasure sites around the world in search of treasures undiscovered. Explore the mysteries behind many famous treasure sites and the riches they bestowed. What lies beyond the artifacts recovered from many of the treasure sites in the Caribbean? Or the grand-daddy of the western sites, "The Lost Dutchman Mine." Join our Treasure crew as they carefully reenact past explorations while continuing their quest for modern day rivers of gold.

TREASURE CHASE (1 x 90) — 1982

Via underwater photography, follow the adventures of three individual crews of divers, photographers, and treasure hunters as they successfully brave the perils of the sea to triumph with the new discoveries. Long lost treasures retrieved range from a multitude of trade goods and silver pesos, to a \$200,000 gold and emerald cross.
