## EPISODES INCLUDE:

### Highland Homicide - San Francisco:

Outside her garden apartment, a woman lies bleeding to death from a dozen stab wounds. Two of San Francisco, California's finest are called to the scene, including Investigator Holly Pera. Holly is the first female homicide inspector in San Francisco's history, experienced in new crime-fighting techniques and technologies. Her partner, Joe "Tombstone" Toomey is a bit more of a skeptic; for him, old-fashioned police instincts are still the best resource. Frustration, false leads, and lucky breaks – we are with them through it all as Holly and Joe make their case using both high-tech innovations and good old-fashioned police work.

### Stemming The Tide - New Orleans:

Trained as a member of the A-team Special Forces of the Green Berets, Sergeant Bruce knows extreme situations and thrives on the thrill of leading a dedicated narcotics team. Detective Skip Daughtry works the other side of the dope world – the burglary beat. As Bruce and his team energetically target street level dealers and "work up the chain" to a big-time dealer, Skip determinedly tracks down leads to a young crack addict, and steers him into a rehab program. As we follow these men with very different approaches but a common goal, we are given a rare view into the complex world of drug trade.

### Gangland - Phoenix:

There is a battle raging on the streets of Phoenix, Arizona for control of the city. On one side are the gangs from the city's poor neighborhoods; on the other, the detectives of Phoenix Police Department's Gang Enforcement Unit. There is also the QRT – Quick Response Team, whose mission is to provide the extra manpower and firepower beyond the scope of regular patrol officers. We track all of these teams as they fight crime, including unprecedented access to a top-secret attack on one of Phoenix's most dangerous street gangs.
