The dedicated doctors, nurses and technical staff provide emergency treatment for all kinds of trauma patients, and the residents hone their skills under the watchful eyes of the attending physicians.

Heart of the Matter: Minneapolis, MN

For the sick and hurt, the place to be is Hennepin County Medical Center. The oldest emergency room in Minnesota, HCMC has kept up with the times with a newly renovated, state of the art facility that boasts 84 private, fully equipped 'cubes' for the more than 90,000 visitors it receives yearly. With these kind of numbers, the emergency room at HCMC is rarely quiet, but the staff handles their cases efficiently, calmly and with great skill.

No matter what their circumstance, when the people of New Haven are injured they put their faith in the staff of Yale-New Haven Hospital. Here, the highly skilled team of doctors and nurses has the power to heal, and faith in their ability to help those who cannot help themselves.
